Scientific research proves that encouraging children to engage in activities after school supports their development.



The Mooseheart Activities enter will create a sense of belonging, improve social skills, provide academic support and offer a safe environment that builds confidence.

Just as we had a hand in helping with the Centennial Project at Moosehaven, we have been called upon to help with this new project at Mooseheart.

The Mooseheart Activity Center (The MAC) is a three year comprehensive project. It includes a new recreation building offering multiple activities: bowling, fitness, ping pong, video games, and more. New street lights and electrical upgrades are needed to provide safe updated streets on the Mooseheart campus. In addition, the demolition of two buildings not viable for any further repairs is necessary.
